



How to attach 2 Extra Panels

If you want to add extra panels or add 2 blinds together, there are a couple easy ways to do this.

You can line up the 2 holes (used for tie downs) and the handles on the edge of each panel and use zip ties or string to tie together as shown in illustration #1.

Of course, use tie downs, anchor stakes or tree branches like we demonstrated in the written instructions and How to Anchor Your Blind Video.

Some customers want to hinge the panels together so they can fold up the blind all at one time.

The easiest way to do this is to lay the 4 panel blind (mirror side up) and 2 panels (mirror side down) as shown in illustration 2.

Line up the edges and drill 4 - 1/8" holes through both panels as shown in illustration 3. Keep the holes approximately 1/2 to 5/8" back from the edge

Install small zip ties loosely through both panels to form a hinge as shown in illustration 4.

Note that the zip tie tensioner is towards the camo side of the blind rather than the mirror side shown in illustration 5. This way they will not interfere with folding the blind.

You will now be able to fold up all 6 panels with the mirror sides to the inside.

If you ever want to take it back apart, just remove the zip ties.
